



**The Henrietta Fire District needs to upgrade the facilities at Fire Station #6 @ 60 Erie Station Rd. (corner of E. River)
This will enhance our ability to provide the highest level of service to the Town of Henrietta.**

The current building was built in the early 1980's with its primary purpose to provide a safe and effective training environment for our volunteer and career firefighters. A new building is needed due to:

- Inadequate building size - more space is needed to house modern fire apparatus and crews
- Building was not designed to house Firefighter/EMTs 24/7
- No facilities for female firefighters
- No decontamination area
- Population growth in this section of Henrietta has created a need for additional resources to increase public safety. We will be adding an engine company manned 24/7 for immediate response.

Being nearly 40 years old, the existing building and training grounds require several updates so we can continue our mission of providing the best training for all of our firefighters. This will allow us to continue to provide the public with the highest level of service going forward.

- New Roof and HVAC for the existing classroom
- Replace parking area with modern energy efficient lighting and proper drainage
- Addition of a residential fire training building and storage facility to provide additional space for training props and equipment.

The Henrietta Fire District has spent the last 2 years studying our options and has determined that building at the current location is the best option. This will allow for future expansion as this area of town continues to grow.

The maximum bond cost is projected to be 16 cents per \$1000 of the assessed value of your property per year.

- \$150,000 house = \$24.00 / year
