Get To Know Your Board of Elections

Located on the first floor, in room 106, of the Gordon A. Howe Monroe County Office Building, the Monroe County Board of Elections (BOE) is open to the public Monday - Friday from 9 am - 5 pm. The BOE is responsible for administering all aspects of elections within the county, and conducts all national, state, county, city, town, and village elections. The BOE is administered by Commissioners of Elections who serve 4-year terms.

Commissioners are elected by the

County Committees of both the Democratic and Republican Party. They are each supported by a Deputy Commissioner and full-time staff. This skilled bipartisan team is responsible for the technical, clerical, and mechanical know how to keep our elections running. They also offer bilingual assistance, information and statistical data to our governmental partners, candidates and the public.



Early Voting runs June 17 - 25, 2023, and is available to all voters in Monroe County. Voters can choose to vote at any of the 13 sites located in Monroe County.

Primary Election Info

- You must be enrolled within a party to participate in the June election.
- Change your address by **June 12, 2023** and **NEW** registrations must be received by **June 17, 2023**
- Your party must have a primary (more candidates running for the same office than seats available).
- Races can be very close and are generally lower turnout due to eligibility - YOUR VOTE MATTERS!

Absentee Ballot Info

- Apply if you will not be present in Monroe County during election time, OR
- Apply if you have a permanent illness or physical disability preventing you from going to the polls.
- Application deadline by mail is **June 12, 2023**. In person deadline in **June 26, 2023**
