Lemon balm	<i>Melissa officinalis</i>
Orange mint	<i>Mentha x piperata f. citrata</i>
Peppermint	<i>Mentha x piperita</i> (a cross between spearmint & watermint)
Spearmint	<i>Mentha spicata</i>
Allium	Globe allium
Daffodil	Narcissus
Hyacinth	<i>Hyacinthus orientalis</i>

This multi-tiered garden was formerly known as the Honey Bee Garden and was established as an Eagle Scout project by BSA Troop 171 in 2013. Both honey bees and native bees are attracted to the nectar and pollen of the flowers. The honey produced by the Tinker Nature Park apiary often has a subtle minty flavor.
