# 2021 Year in Review

- Due to the pandemic which began in 2020, the Town took measures to budget conservatively for the 2021 Budget year.
  - We removed a couple big ticket items from the budget.
  - We reduced the growth rate of other items in the budget.
  - We assumed revenues would be closer to the lower
     2020 levels rather than 2019 levels.

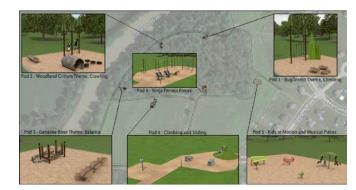

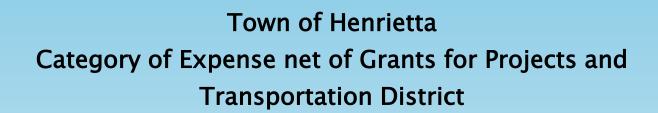

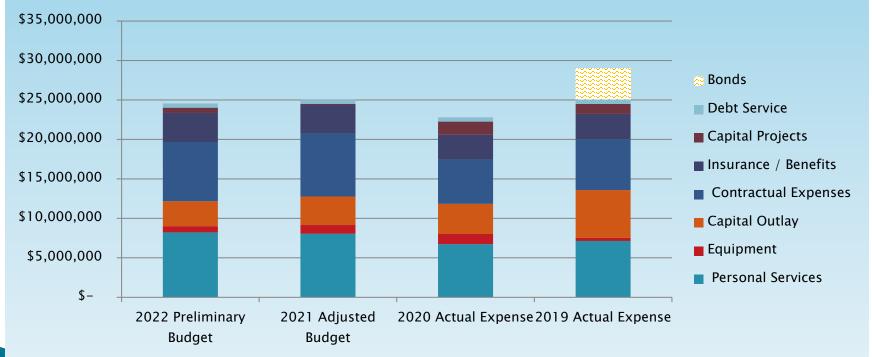

# Tax Levy vs Tax Rate

- The Tax Levy is the sum total of how much we collect in property taxes
- The Tax Rate is the Tax Levy divided by the Total Assessed Value of Taxable Properties in Town and is generally expressed as an amount per \$1,000 of assessed value
- So, for instance, if you have a \$4-Million tax levy and \$3.2-Billion in taxable properties, then the Tax Rate would be \$1.25 per \$1,000 of assessed value

# When do Taxes Increase?

- Some politicians love to claim they didn't raise taxes. What they generally mean is they didn't raise the Tax Rate.
- But when you hold the Tax Rate flat, you ARE increasing taxes if any portion of the Total Growth is due to rising assessments.
- If you only increase the Tax Levy by the amount of the Real Growth or less, then you are truly holding taxes flat.

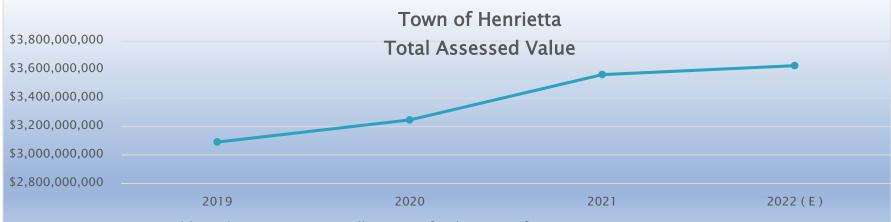

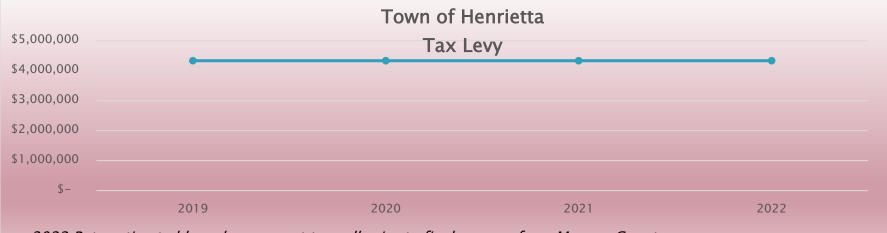
\* Per GASB, the fund balance is measured against the next year's projected expenditures, so we created a rough estimate by growing this year's expenditures based on trending.

Estimated Fund Balance at 12/31/22 of the aggregated funds above is 20.25%. This falls within our Fund Balance Policy as resolved in July 2019. The target amount is 20%, with a floor of 19% and a ceiling of 25%.

#### Year over Year Assessed Value and Tax Levies

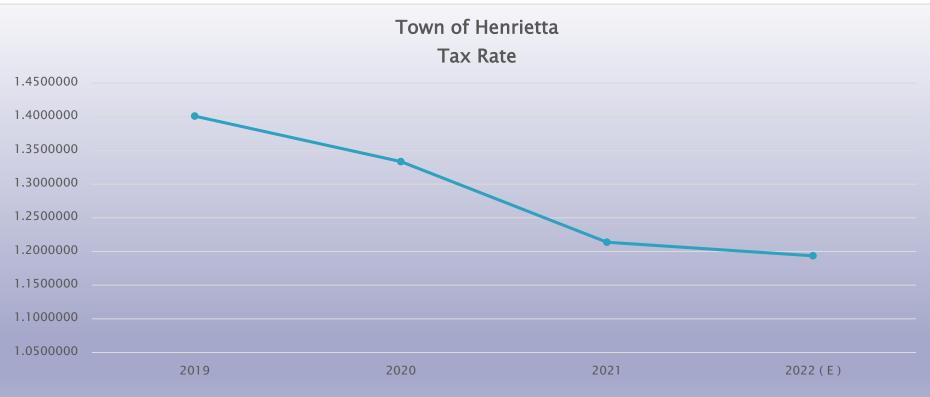


2022 Rate estimated based on current tax roll prior to final numers from Monroe County

# 2022 Projected Special District Rate Changes

Special Districts:

Drainage – Rate remains the same as 2021 and the levy slightly increased by an estimated \$4,580 from new units only

Sewer – Rate remains the same as 2021 and the levy slightly increased by an estimated \$6,867 from new units only

Parks – Tax levy and rate remains the same as 2021



#### 2022 Preliminary Budget Distribution

The 2022 Tentative Budget was distributed to the Town Board on October 6, 2021. Based on meetings with Town Board Members, adjustments were made. The Tentative Budget was forwarded to the Town Clerk on October 13<sup>th</sup>. During the October 13, 2021 Town Board Meeting, a resolution was passed to call for a Public Hearing on the Preliminary Budget to be held on October 28<sup>th</sup>.

The Preliminary Budget was forwarded to the Town Clerk on October 19<sup>th</sup> in advance of the Public Hearing.

### 2022 Preliminary Budget Inclusions

Addressing needs for the Town with additional positions:

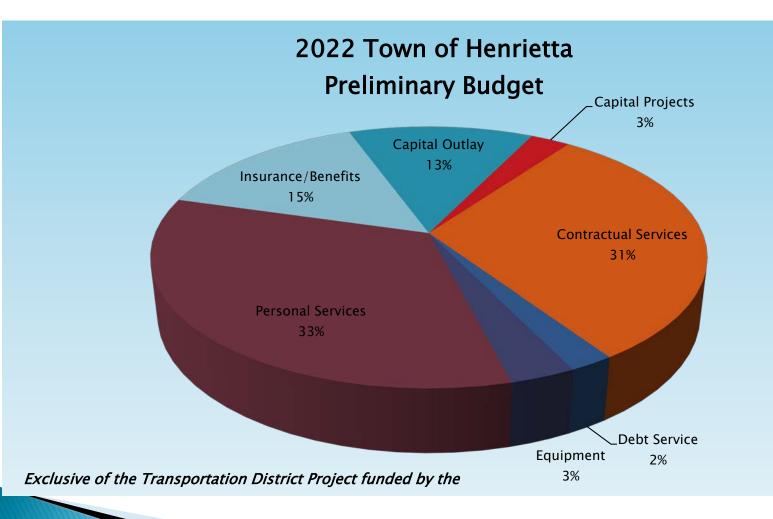
- Building and Grounds Maintenance: +2
  - Increased mowing capacity
  - Increased facility maintenance
- Highway Department: +1
  - Increased plowing and paving capacity

### 2022 Preliminary Budget Inclusions

#### Equipment and Capital Outlay:

- Standard Scheduled Equipment Replacement per annual schedule
- Projects planned in 2022:
  - Renovations required at Good Shepherd \$60,000
  - Sewer & Drainage Garage rebid \$570,000
- Tentative Projects included in the 2022 budget (dependent on additional funding and approvals):
  - Sidewalk project for E. Henrietta Rd \$136,000 (net of a Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) grant which has been applied for this year)
  - Purchase and enhancements to Chapman Corners Park \$230,000
  - Park enhancements \$100,000

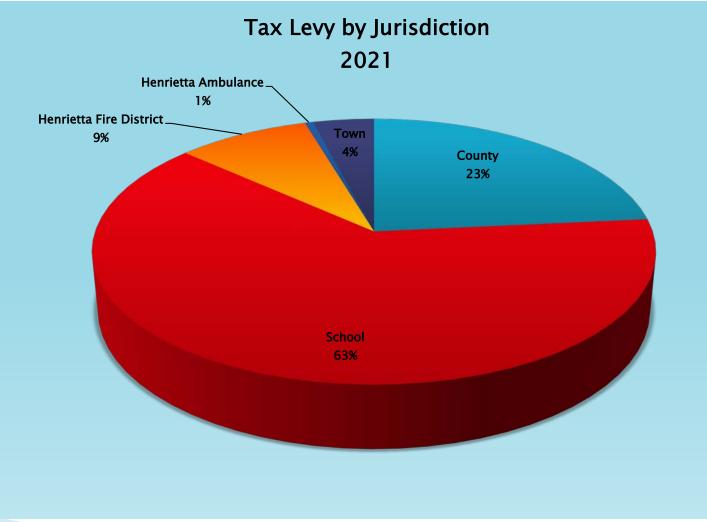

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# **Announced Tax Levy Changes**

- > 2021-22 Rush-Henrietta CSD, School Tax:
  - Tax rate lower by -0.7%, levy increases by 2.0%
- > 2022 Town of Henrietta, Town Tax:
  - Tax rate lower by 1.7%, levy \$0 change (Town Tax)
  - Same rate, \$0 change (Drainage charges)
  - Same rate, \$0 change (Sewer rent)
- > 2022 Henrietta Fire District, Fire Tax:
  - Tax rate same, levy increases by 2.44%
- > 2022 CHS Mobile Health, Ambulance Tax:
  - Tax rate increases slightly, levy increases by 3.0%
- > 2022 Monroe County, County Tax:
