WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution #22-268/2002 adopted by the Henrietta Town Board on November 20, 2002, a Public Hearing was duly held at the Henrietta Town Hall, 475 Calkins Road, Henrietta, New York on December 18, 2002 for the purpose of considering and hearing all persons interested in the adoption of an ordinance pertaining to Article X of the Henrietta Zoning Code, entitled "Historic Sites," and

WHEREAS, after due consideration, the Town Board finds that the adoption of the following ordinance is in the best interest of the Town of Henrietta.
