

RESOLUTION #27-231/81

On motion of Councilman Murphy, seconded by Councilman Klein:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution #23-183/81 adopted by the Henrietta Town Board on October 21, 1981 the public hearing was duly held at the Henrietta Town Hall at 475 Calkins Road, Henrietta, New York on November 18, 1981 for the purpose of considering, and hearing all persons interested in, the adoption of an Ordinance amending Article IX of the Henrietta Zoning Code, entitled "Historic Sites", and
WHEREAS, at such hearing all persons interested in the said Ordinance, both in favor of and opposed to, were given an opportunity to be heard, and
WHEREAS, after due consideration the Town Board finds that the adoption of the following Ordinance is in the best interest of the Town of Henrietta,

RESOLVED, that the following Ordinance be and it hereby is adopted;
Ordained by the Town Board of the Town of Henrietta:

1. Article IX of the Henrietta Zoning Code, entitled "Historic Sites" be and it hereby is amended by adding thereto following Section 127-35, Appendix A to read as follows:

c. The property owned by Mary E. Gagnon, located at 593 Pinnacle Road, Henrietta, New York, Section Block & Lot #176.080-01-072.

d. The property owned by Rochester Institute of Technology, located at 2201 Lehigh Station Road, Henrietta, New York, Section Block & Lot #176.160-01-034.

e. The property owned by Robert Whyte, located at 5015 East River Road, Henrietta, New York. Section Block & Lot #188.010-01-022.2.

f. The property owned by Glen A. Tinker & wife, located at 1585 Calkins Road, Henrietta, New York, Section Block & Lot #163.170-01-002.

g. The property owned by Donald W. Webber, located at 255 Tobin Road, Henrietta, New York, Section Block & Lot #190.020-01-058.

h. The property owned by William T. Gross, Jr., located at 877 Telephone Road, Henrietta, New York, Section Block & Lot #201.010-01-04.

i. The property known as the Bullard-Gruschow House, located at 830 Telephone Road, Henrietta, New York, Section Block & Lot #201.020-02-017.

j. The property owned by Leland Bushman, located at 633 Telephone Road Henrietta, New York, Section Block & Lot #201.020-02-003.

k. The property owned by Louis Hemplemann, located at 283 Castle Road, Henrietta, New York, Section Block & Lot #162.150-02-041.

l. The property owned by Rocco Pellegrino, located at 3059 East Henrietta Road, Henrietta, New York, Section Block & Lot #176.100-01-089.

2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk be and he hereby is directed to give notice of the adoption of this Ordinance by publication and posting as required by law.

SUPERVISOR KELLY:

COUNCILMAN KLEIN:

COUNCILMAN BREESE:

I certainly join in commending Mr. Murphy for the hard work he's put on this Committee. I do have a question about property owned by Glen A. Tinker and wife.

SUPERVISOR KELLY:

Yes.

COUNCILMAN BREESE:

I believe that Mr. Tinker died some time around the time this hearing was going on. Do we have specific consent for that property being included in the Historical District?

COUNCILMAN MURPHY:

I think he died prior to that hearing, Mr. Breese. Mr. Tinker's daughter came not to the public hearing but to the informational hearing we had at the Library and at that time indicated an interest in joining the Historic Site. The only ones that have not were the two that spoke at the public hearing, the Halpin property; I found out today Mrs. Nowik who was not part of the public hearing held recently, who has a potential of selling her house to the post office, I guess. You may notice there's one here on East Henrietta Road from a previous public hearing. Mr. Pellagrino contacted me and asked to be included.
