GENERAL CONSTRUCTION NOTES

1. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL DAMAGES AND REPAIRS TO ALL UTILITIES, PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ROADWAYS, SIDEWALKS AND STRUCTURES, INCLUDING SIGNS, RESULTING FROM HIS OPERATIONS.
2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE SATISFACTORY VEHICULAR AND PEDESTRIAN ACCESS TO PROPERTIES DURING CONSTRUCTION.
3. STOCKPILING OF EXCAVATED MATERIALS OR CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS ON PAVEMENT OR WITHIN RIGHT-OF-WAY SHALL **NOT** BE PERMITTED. ALL EXCESS MATERIAL SHALL BE PROMPTLY REMOVED FROM THE SITE.
4. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL POST PROPER WARNING SIGNS PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION. ALL EXCAVATIONS SHALL BE PROPERLY BACKFILLED AT END OF EACH WORKING DAY. NO OPEN EXCAVATIONS WILL BE PERMITTED. ALL CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT SHALL BE REMOVED FROM SITE AT END OF DAY.
5. ROAD SHALL BE SWEEPED CLEAN AT THE END OF EACH WORK DAY AS REQUIRED. CALCIUM CHLORIDE SHALL BE USED TO LIMIT DUST, AND DRAINAGE SHALL BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES.
6. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE PROOF OF GENERAL AND AUTOMOTIVE LIABILITY AND WORKMANS COMPENSATION INSURANCE COVERAGE SHOWING TOWN OF HENRIETTA AS ADDITIONAL INSURED.
7. THE CONTRACTOR MUST CONTACT DIG SAFELY VIA 811 AT LEAST TWO BUSINESS DAYS PRIOR TO COMMENCING THE WORK AND HAVE VERIFIED ALL UTILITIES IN THE EXCAVATION AREA ARE MARKED AND OR CLEARED.

CONTRACTOR HEREBY AGREES TO HOLD THE TOWN OF HENRIETTA HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFIED FROM ANY AND ALL CLAIMS ARISING OUT OF CONTRACTOR'S ACTS OR OMISSIONS WHILE WORKING UNDER PERMIT #149 OF THE TOWN OF HENRIETTA PURSUANT TO THIS AGREEMENT.
