6.	THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE PROOF OF GENERAL AND AUTOMOTIVE LIABILITY AND WORKMANS COMPENSATION INSURANCE COVERAGE SHOWING TOWN OF HENRIETTA AS ADDITIONAL INSURED.
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7.	THE CONTRACTOR MUST CONTACT DIG SAFELY VIA 811 AT LEAST TWO BUSINESS DAYS PRIOR TO COMMENCING
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	COMPENSATION INSURANCE COVERAGE SHOWING TOWN OF HENRIETTA AS ADDITIONAL INSURED.
